The scholarship will reward an outstanding African American high school senior who exhibits financial need. This scholarship is administered through the Afro-American Historical & Genealogical Society, Arkansas Chapter.

AMOUNT AND TERM OF AWARD

Annual Scholarship with a one-time award of \$500.00 awarded in the month of May of the academic year following high school graduation.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR RECEIVING SCHOLARSHIP

- The student must be an African American high school senior who has made his/her choice of a 2- or 4-year college or university or trade school.
- Applicant must be a graduate from the Little Rock School District
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00
- Must provide evidence of leadership potential, academic achievement, integrity, good conduct, and financial need.
- Must write a 300-word essay answering the following question: Define Courage and how it can best be used to improve the conditions within your community?
- To be considered, student must submit their current transcript, student resume and two reference letters. The resume should include a listing of high school activities, awards, and recognitions.
